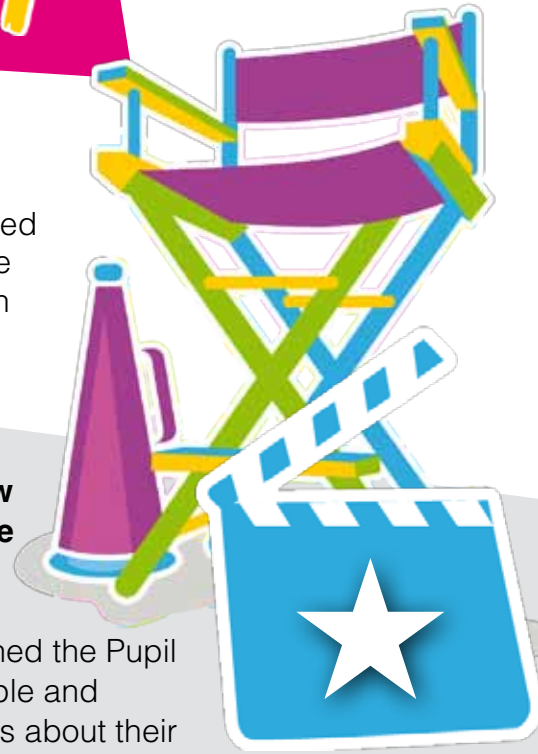

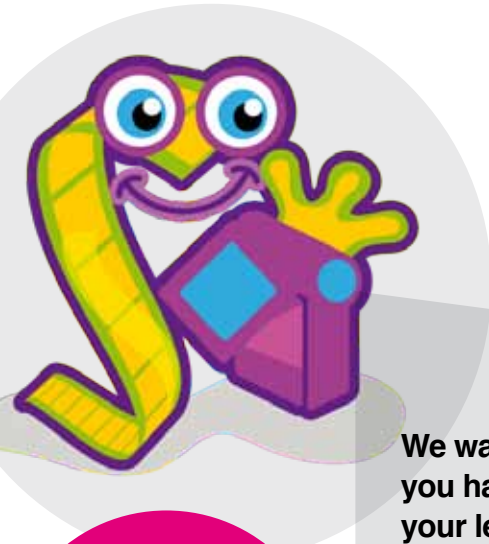
Create a video clip expressing one or all of the following:

Please make sure you **name your video** in both the entry **form** and in the video **clip**.
