

Student Parliament Structure: Barry Comprehensive School

All student voice groups to be coordinated under one umbrella organisation with opportunities for maximising student engagement and enabling students to take leadership roles, minimising need for teacher facilitation.

All groups to be further facilitated, and collaboration and dissemination enabled, by BCS Voice online social network.

Head Boy & Head Girl:
Chair & Vice Chair of Student Parliament
Elected from Year 13 students

Student Cabinet: 5 Departments, each led by 6th Form 'Minister' and 'Secretary' elected from Year 12/13 Year Councils who join Cabinet meetings with Head Boy & Head Girl once per $\frac{1}{2}$ term. Report to - and supported by - Assistant Head.

Departments also include 2 Council members per year group (total min. 12 students per department) selected by application from Year Councils + co-opted volunteers as required. Meetings minimum once per $\frac{1}{2}$ term but frequency as required to be decided by Minister.



Year Councils: 2 Students elected from each form group. Led by Chair & Secretary and guided by Pastoral Coordinators

Year Councillors apply to join departments. Selected by Cabinet Ministers & Secretaries. Meetings once per $\frac{1}{2}$ term.
